The HP ePrint App makes printing easy, from your iPhone, iPad, iPod Touch, Android phone or Blackberry, whether you are at home, in the office, or on the go.

Main Features:

- Print from your phone over Wi-Fi, via the Internet to an HP ePrint printer, or directly to HP wireless direct supported printers. [1] [2]
- Print to convenient HP Public Print Locations, like print/copy stores, hotels, and airport lounges. [1] [3]
- Supports HP ePrint Enterprise (service and internet purchased separately). For more information, check http://www.hp.com/go/eprintenterprise [4]
- Select and print photos and content from your email and the web. Supports most major file types (Microsoft Office documents, web pages, email attachments, photos, PDF and text files).

- [5] Other apps must provide individual access to files and enable exposure to these registered document type handlers from Android.
- [6] Printing capability via ePrint; requires Blackberry Internet Service for HP Public Print Locations; using Blackberry with HP ePrint Enterprise requires BlackBerry Enterprise Server (BES) deployment. Printing via a direct wireless connection with printer is not supported for BlackBerry® devices.
