It has now partnered with the Net Zero Group and adopted an enhanced sustainability policy, underpinned by a 'route map' focused on reducing its Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions:

- **Scope 1 (direct emissions from owned or controlled sources)**
- **Scope 2 (in-direct emissions from the generation of purchased energy)**
- **Scope 3 (all in-direct emissions from the value chain)**
